Voino-Yasenetsky Krasnoyarsk State Medical University. The Forum will be held from the 2nd to the 4th of February 2022.

The Forum aims to provide a wide range of stakeholders with the opportunity to exchange their theoretical knowledge, research results, and teaching experience in order to improve the quality of medical and pharmaceutical education through the integration of science and practice.

Forum holding form: both offline and online.

The following All-Russian competitions with international participation will be held within the framework of the Forum on the 2nd of February 2022:

The major Forum events are scheduled for the 3rd and the 4th of February 2022. They include:

SYMPOSIA:

– Digital transformation, ensuring the quality and accessibility of education (digital model of the educational institution, specialty, discipline, and practical class).

- Pedagogy and medicine for the benefit of man (a humanistic and personal approach in medical education; a modern model of the teacher's psychological and pedagogical activity, effective pedagogical technology in medical education).

- Internationalization of medical education and export of educational services (exchange of experience in language teaching, international activity and implementation of educational programs using an intermediary language).

- Training of the specialist of the future:

- simulation training in medicine;
- continuing medical education;
- accreditation of healthcare professionals;
- assistance in employment and professional career support.

- Secondary medical and pharmaceutical education - modernization in the face of modern challenges.

- Creation of an effective system for identifying, supporting and developing young people's abilities and talents.

- Inclusive education - experience in guidance for individuals with disabilities and special needs.

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TERMS OF PARTICIPATION AND PUBLICATION

Registration

- **Registration** on the site is available until 25.01.2022.
- Submission of the publications on the site is available until $5.01.2022 \text{ } \Gamma$.
- 1. Working languages of the forum: Russian, English.
- Requirements for the manuscript
- No more than **<u>one</u>** scientific work is accepted from one author.

• The volume of the text of the article: 5-7 A4 pages (from 12,000 to 17,000 characters).

• The file name (in Russian or English) must correspond to the surname and initials of the first author without spaces (for example, ПетровАН.doc or PetrovAN.doc).

• The text must be prepared in the MS Word text editing programme, with the extension .doc or .docx, font Times New Roman Cyr, 14 pt, line spacing one and a half. Margins: left 3 cm, top, bottom, right - 2 cm. A4 sheet. Page orientation - portrait, justified alignment, paragraph indent - 1.25. There should be no hyphenation in the text of the article. The material should be formatted in accordance with the rules of the modern Russian language.

• When writing an article in English, all items are filled out in English.

Detailed requirements for the formatting of articles are given in the Appendix 1.

Materials submitted in compliance with all the requirements for the design and presentation of the text will be placed in the RSCI database (<u>http://elibrary.ru</u>).

The organizers reserve the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements for article formatting.
